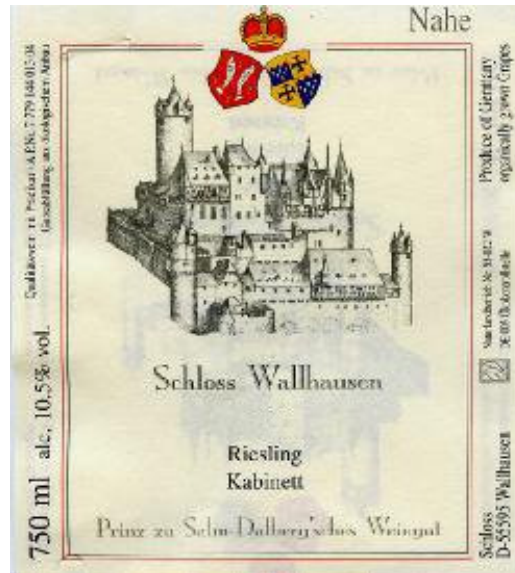


Schloss Wallhausen Riesling Kabinett 2004



Schloss Wallhausen Kabinett is a blend between the two famous sites Felseneck and Johannisberg, both located in Wallhausen. Both vineyard sites are classified vineyard sites. Felseneck's soil is a green slate, which is only found around Wallhausen and it gives the wine elegance, acidity and foremost minerality. Johannisberg's soil adds the fruit and power to the wine.

This exquisite Riesling displays a perfect balance between sweetness, acidity and minerality. Exotic flavours of apricot, nectarine and yellow plum are enhanced with a crisp lime acidity and a long, mineral finish
